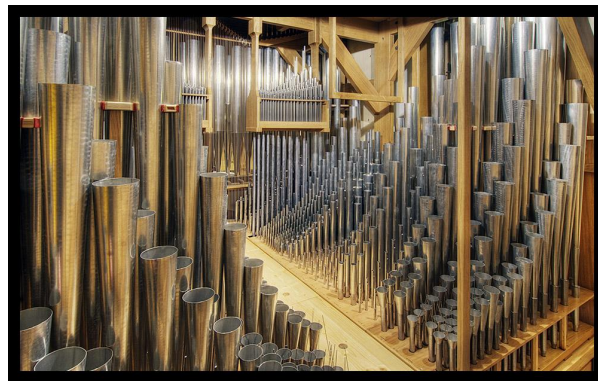

This concert will feature professional trumpet soloists Brooks & Jeff Holmes, vocalist Dawning Holmes and organist Jeff Windoloski. Selections will be presented for trumpet and organ, voice and piano, and a combination of the three!

Brooks Holmes serves as the Band Director for Michael E. Smith Middle School in South Hadley where he leads over 100 students in instrumental music. Brooks earned a Bachelor's and Master's degree from UMASS Amherst. He enjoys playing trumpet for concerts throughout the state as both a soloist and trumpeter with the New England Brass Quartet for the past 25 years.

Jeff Holmes is a nationally published pianist, composer, arranger, and trumpeter. He has performed around the world including Russia, Japan, and Australia, and was a featured artist at the Washington D.C. Kennedy Center series. Professor of Music at the University of Massachusetts Amherst, Holmes directs the award-winning UMASS Jazz Ensemble and Studio Orchestra. Jeff received his Bachelors and Masters degrees from the Eastman School of Music.

Dawning Holmes is a vocalist, composer and lyricist. In addition to her work with Jeff Holmes Big Band, she has sung in ensembles from New York City to London, has guested with both Paul Winter and the UMASS Studio Orchestra/Jazz Ensemble.



Jeff Windoloski presently serves as Director of Music at St. John's Lutheran Church. In addition to his role, Jeff also directs the 'Soli Deo Gloria' concert series which he founded in the summer of 2016.

Following graduation with his Bachelor's degree, Jeff served as organist at First Lutheran Church of Holyoke MA from 2014 until his appointment at St. John's. He particularly enjoys performing music drawn from the rich musical heritage of the Lutheran Church and the German Baroque era, and also has great enthusiasm for improvising in the Baroque style based on the church's hymnody.
